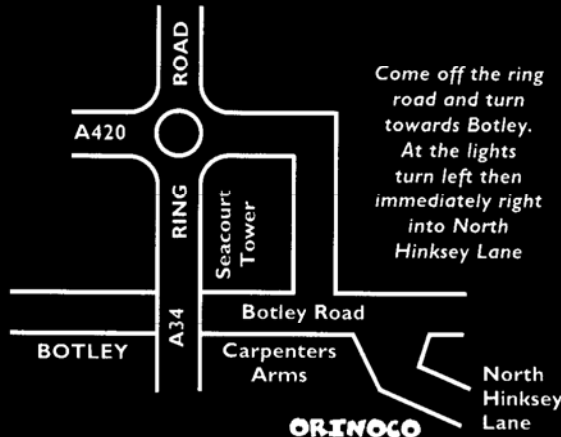
How can my group get paint?
